PROVISIONAL DRIVING LICENCES

Anyone wishing to obtain a BHRC Driving Licence should complete Page 1 of this application form and return along with two passport photographs to BHRC Office, Burlington Crescent, Goole, East Yorkshire, DN14 5EG, along with any necessary fees. The applicant should advise the BHRC Office of the date and track at which they intend to be present to complete a demonstration of their driving skills and ability in front of necessary officials. If deemed suitable to drive by the necessary officials, the applicant will receive a Provisional Licence. This licence allows the holder to drive in qualifiers only. The Provisional driver must wear some clearly visible arm band or other distinguishing item as directed by the racetrack management.

Before and after driving in qualifiers the provisional licence holder must report to the Regional Steward who will sign and complete details on the Licence Card. After driving in a minimum of THREE qualifying races, the holder will be eligible to take a DRIVING TEST. Driving tests can be taken at approved racetracks - anyone wishing to take a test must apply to the racetrack giving seven days notice. (Approved tracks are hard and grass tracks with mobile starting gates.) The TEST will be conducted in a qualifying race - two A class drivers and at least six horses must compete in the race. The Provisional driver will start on the gate and must complete the race in qualifying time. After the race, opinions of the A class drivers will be sought before the Regional Steward will continue with the test on the Rules of the BHRC (a written format of questions).

If successful, the Provisional licence card will be endorsed by the BHRC Regional Steward and the card should be forwarded to the BHRC office with the appropriate fee. (As per present C Class Licence plus Registration and Calendar fee, plus £2 Colours Registration). Should the applicant fail the test, this will be recorded on the card and a report sent to the BHRC office. The applicant may re-apply for a further test after two more drives in qualifying races.

Any infringement of the above rules by the Provisional driver will result in a suspension of the licence for a period of not less than three months, and a fine not in excess of £50.
