**All vehicles; cars & wagons to enter the race field by the Grammar school entrance.
The bridge entrance is for pedestrians only.**

There will only be 10 races per race day to include the finals. Horse entries will be accepted on a **first entered and paid** basis. No money taken on day for security reasons. All heat entries to take priority over Maiden & Novice. **Horseboxes will be checked**, any stowaways found will result in all occupants removed from track & horses will not be allowed to run.

Qualifiers, Maiden & Novice Races will be held on both Sunday & Monday

EVENT 1: QUALIFIERS 1Mile. Horses need full vaccinations.

All qualifier events to take place after the final.

Entry Fee £20

EVENT 2: MAIDEN & NOVICE RACES. 1M 50 YDS B.F.P. They will be no splitting of horses for owner/trainer/driver.

Prize Money £300 £120 £80

EVENT 3: Grade 1 Straight Races. 1M 500 YDS.

Prize Money £500 £150 £100

(Min 8 horses)

Entry Fee £45

EVENT 4: 3 YEAR OLD GRASS PACING CHAMPIONSHIP. 1M 50YDS.

Entry fee £140 paid as follows;

1. £80 Non-refundable nomination fee to be paid by 1st April using the slip on the 3-year-old nomination form.
2. £60 Entry fee to be paid by Saturday 11th May.

Horses can be supplemented after 1st April for a fee of £250 & the entry fee of £60 by 11th May.

If sufficient entries one mixed race will take place **£1000 £500 £200**. Fillies to receive preferential draw. If sufficient declarations two races will take place. £500 £200 £150. Note no final will take place. Colts & fillies will be run in separate races again, if sufficient declarations. Fillies to receive preferential draw when races are mixed. All 3 year old horses must have qualified before race day.

If by the close of nominations on the 1st April there are less than 10 nominations the committee reserve the right to withdraw the 3 Year old Grass Championship and a full refund to all nominees will be made.

The breeder of the winner / fastest time horse in the Appleby 3 year old championship will receive £500 as part of the STAGBI Breeders Bonus. (Providing that the horse holds a STAGBI passport & the breeder is a member of STAGBI)

EVENT 5: 2 Year Old race. 1M 50YDS.

Fillies to receive preferential draw.

(Min. 6 horses)

Prize Money £275 £75 £50

Entry Fee £30

EVENT 6: A non-penalty conditional race for horses who have not won in their last 8 completed races. This is for Open horses, grades to be run in lines. 1M 500YDS. (Min. 8 horses)

Prize Money £400 £120 £80

Entry Fee £40

EVENT 7: Conditional race for trainers who train less than 10 horses. This is for Open horses, grades to be run in lines. 1½ miles (Min. 8 horses)

Prize Money £400 £120 £80

Entry Fee £40

Monday 27th May

EVENT 8: PACING HANDICAP for Grade 2+ horses. 1M 500 YDS.

Entry Fee £50

The heats are to be framed on the horse's money won on the closing date of the entries. No splitting of horses for owner / trainer/ driver.

Heat Prize Money £700 £200 £100

Final Prize Money plus Heat Winnings: £5000 £1500 £700

The breeder of the winner in the Monday final will receive £100 as part of the STAGBI Breeders Bonus. (Providing that the horse holds a STAGBI passport & the breeder is a member of STAGBI)

Horses will be framed under handicap rule.

No jogging between races, jogging only permitted if condition of track allows. Horse's position on gate or line determined by monies won; horse with less money won placed inside horse with more money won.

Horses with same money B.F.P.

The Appleby Spring Race committee reserve the right to alter the above conditions if circumstances dictate.

Appleby Races Track Rules

1. Both the Veterinary Surgeon and the Integrity Officer and/or Chief Track Steward for Appleby will wear body cameras to record the process of integrity testing at our events
2. The final winner at Appleby Spring will be subject to sampling for Integrity Testing. Any other horses selected in accordance with sections F16, Y1 and Y4 of the BHRC Rules and Regulations will also be subject to sampling for Integrity Testing.
3. In accordance with Appendix V of the BHRC Rules and Regulations, there will be an appointed area for testing. All horses chosen for sampling will be escorted to this area and may be stripped of harness and washed down once present at the appointed area (water and equipment to be provided by the trainer). In accordance with section Y5 of the BHRC Rules, the trainer or their representative may be present to witness the collection of the sample. Should a trainer chose not to witness this process (or nominate a representative), they must sign a declaration before the sample is taken in which they agree that the integrity of the sampling procedure will not be questioned at a later date. No additional personnel may accompany the horse due to Health & Safety (save for if permission is granted by officials).
