ENTRIES CLOSE 9.00pm Sunday 18th AUGUST 2019 – Enter early as limited to 10 races including final.

Event 1: OPEN HANDICAP Grades 2+. 1M 500Yds. Heats: 1st £500, 2nd £200, 3rd £100. Final: 1st £1000, 2nd £300, 3rd £100. **Entry Fee £50**

Event 2: Maiden & Novice. 1M 50Yds. 1st £300, 2nd £70, 3rd £40. **Entry Fee £40**

Event 3: Grade 1 Straight Race. 1M 500Yds. 1st £350, 2nd £80, 3rd £40. **Entry Fee £40**

Event 4: NHR Invitational Race – 1 mile and a half, 10 horses, straight race, horse owners/trainers will receive personal invites. 1st £500, 2nd £200, 3rd £100. **Entry Fee £45**

Event 5: Qualifier & Workouts-After Racing. Entry Fee £20.

Please note Maiden, Novice and Grade 1 - ballot for position regardless of monies won. All other grades starting position dependent on monies won, horses on same money ballot for position. Any horse on provisional start sheet is liable for full entry fee. The committee reserve the right to alter the above conditions if circumstances dictate. Provisional Start sheet will be published on Northern Harness Racing Facebook page, final start sheet will be published on BHRC website.

Appleby Race Track Rules:

1. Both the integrity officer and vet &/or chief steward for Appleby will wear body cameras to record the process of integrity testing at our events.
2. The final winner at Brough will be subject to sampling for integrity testing. Any other horses selected in accordance with sections F16, Y1 & Y4 of the BHRC rules and regulations will also be subject to sampling for integrity testing.
3. In accordance with appendix V of the BHRC Rules and Regulations, there will be an appointed area for testing. All horses chosen for sampling will be escorted to this area and may be stripped of any harness and washed down once present at the area (water and equipment to be provided by the trainer). In accordance with section Y5 of BHRC Rules and Regulations, the trainer or their representative may be present to witness the collection of the sample. Should a trainer choose not to witness this process (or nominated representative) they must sign a declaration before the sample is taken in which they agree that the integrity of sampling procedure will not be questioned at a later date. No additional personnel may accompany the horse due to health and safety (save for if permission is granted by officials).

It is the condition of entry that: 1) the proprietors, promoters, EVHRA & all officials in any capacity will not be responsible for damage, injury or loss sustained by owners, trainers, drivers or horses. Owners, trainers & drivers must satisfy themselves as to the safety of the course before competing 2) Brough races adhere to the BHRC Privacy Policy 3) owners and trainers agree to the Appleby Races track rules
