ONLINE ENTRIES CLOSE Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2021 @ midnight

All vehicles: cars & wagons to enter the race field by the Grammar school entrance.

The bridge entrance is for pedestrians only. Horseboxes will be checked, stowaways found will result in all occupants removed from track & horses will not be allowed to run.

The BHRC Coronavirus protocol will be adhered to at this race meeting.

There will <u>only be 10 races</u> this year, priority given to the handicap. Horses rated 32 & above will run either in the straight races or handicap depending on the entries received. Entries taken on a first entered basis. **Once the 10 races are compiled reserves will be taken.** 

EVENT 1 **QUALIFIERS 1Mile.** Horses need full vaccinations

All qualifier events to take place after the final.

Entry Fee £20

EVENT 2 **Condition race for horses with no lifetime wins** (Maiden) **1M 50 YDS B.F.P.** They will be no

splitting of horses for owner/trainer/driver. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served

basis, if over-subscribed names will go on a waiting list.

Prize Money £300 £60 £40 **Entry Fee £40** 

EVENT 3 Condition race for horses with one, but no more than one lifetime win. (Novice) 1M 50 YDS

**B.F.P.** They will be no splitting of horses for owner/trainer/driver. Places will be allocated on a

first-come, first-served basis, if over-subscribed names will go on a waiting list.

Prize Money £300 £60 £40 **Entry Fee £40** 

**EVENT 4 Appleby New Fair Races Pacing Handicap for horses rated 32-120. 1M 500 YDS.** 

10 YDS trail for every 10 rating points, from highest rated horse down. The 40 rated horses entered for the Appleby New Fair Races Pacing Handicap will run in the heats. The remaining horses will run in a max of 2 straight races. No Owner/Trainer/Driver splits. Races drawn using the horse's handicap ratings. All horses with the same handicap ratings will be balloted for their starting position and if need be, to attain the cut off point for the top 40 rated horses for the handicap. Heats and final run as handicap.

## EVENT 5 Conditional straight Race for horses who miss the handicap cut, but who have had two lifetime wins. (Min 10 horses, max 20 horses) 1M 500 YDS.

They will be no splitting of horses for owner/trainer/driver. All horses with the same handicap ratings will be balloted for their starting position. Run as a handicap. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, if over-subscribed names will go on a waiting list.

Horses will be framed under the National Ratings Based Handicap System.

No jogging between races, jogging only permitted if condition of track allows. Horse's starting position on gate or line determined by handicap rating; horse with lowest rating placed inside horse with higher rating. Horses with same handicap rating B.F.P. The Appleby New Fair Race committee reserve the right to alter the above conditions if circumstances dictate.

## **Appleby Races Track Rules**

- 1. Officials: BHRC stewards, Integrity Officer, Eden Valley Stewards and gate stewards for Appleby will wear body cameras to record the process of racing and integrity testing at our events.
- 2. The final winner at Appleby New Fair Races will be subject to sampling for Integrity Testing. Other horses selected in accordance with sections F16 & Y of the BHRC Rules and Regulations will be subject to sampling for Integrity Testing.
- 3. In accordance with Appendix V of the BHRC Rules and Regulations, there will be an appointed area for testing. All horses chosen for sampling will be escorted to this area and may be stripped of harness and washed down once present at the appointed area (water and equipment to be provided by the trainer). In accordance with section Y of the BHRC Rules, the trainer or their representative may be present to witness the collection of the sample. Should a trainer choose not to witness this process (or nominate a representative), they must sign a declaration before the sample is taken in which they agree that the integrity of the sampling procedure will not be questioned later. No additional personnel may accompany the horse due to Health & Safety.
